Exciting News: A New Chapter for Shepherd's Canyon Retreat

We are thrilled to announce that Shepherd's Canyon Retreat has been blessed with a second site!! It is a 5,000-square-foot home on a serene 55-acre lake in **Lake Ozark, Missouri**.



This expansion comes as a response to the growing number of pastors and ministry leaders seeking help, hope and healing. The new space will place our ministry within a day's drive of 12 states and over 100,000 churches, making our retreats more accessible to more church workers.

With our Arizona site nearing capacity, this lakeside retreat is an incredible opportunity to continue our mission of serving those in ministry. We invite you to join us in prayer, support, and partnership as we prepare to welcome guests to this sanctuary of grace and peace.



The previous owners, **Pastor Kris & Sheri Morris**, purchased the property in 2019, and it required extensive renovations, so a dedicated church member spent two years helping Pastor Morris restore it. Tragically, just six months after the pastor's family moved in, that church member and his wife were killed.

Later, when Pastor Morris accepted a position at Concordia University in Nebraska, he and his wife felt it would be a meaningful tribute to the man who had devoted so much time and effort to help one pastor and family...to sell their home to a ministry that serves pastors and other ministry workers in need of healing and renewal. They wanted this church member's legacy of service and generosity towards his pastor's family to continue.

Tawn and I met Pastor Kris Morris at a conference in Nebraska in September 2024 when he told us about their home. I said "it sounds perfect, but we don't have any money." In October, Tawn and I went to see the house in person, and we loved it, but "we still don't have any money to buy it," I said.

A week later, we took some friends of ours, Michael & Caryn Borland, out to eat and showed them a presentation about how God has been blessing the ministry and asked for them to partner with us in making this happen. **The Borland Family Foundation** agreed to give us nearly a million dollars to buy the house. We are so grateful to them and to God for the ability to bless church workers in this way. We now need other donors to provide for other needs for that property. Can you help us?

The house is beautiful, but we have some projects that need to be done. This Spring and Summer, we will need volunteers to help with light construction, painting, and preparing the home. Additionally, we are seeking financial support to purchase materials like lumber, drywall, and paint, as well as high-quality furniture to ensure a welcoming and comfortable environment for our guests.

Beyond this, we are exploring the opportunity to acquire additional land and a nearby home, which would enhance our ability to house volunteers, staff, therapists, and chaplains. To make this possible, we are seeking donors willing to invest in this vision. Might God allow you to help?
